Instrumental Music Scholarship Year 7 in 2023

Bracken Ridge State High School (BRSHS) will be offering four (4) *Instrumental Music Scholarships* to students joining the school community as **Year 7 students in 2023**.

Scholarships are offered to recognise the student's exemplary achievements and talents in the area of *Instrumental Music*. Applications must be a current Year 6 Instrumental Music student.

Successful applications will receive a bursary amount of \$500 to be used for the Instrumental Music activities including instrument hire, levies/fees, band uniforms and excursions.

Application Process

If you are interested in applying for the *Instrumental Music Scholarship*:

- 1. Complete the application available from the school office or school website
- Return the completed application form to Bracken Ridge State High School, Administration Office, in an envelope clearly marked 'INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC SCHOLARSHIP.'
 - Applications close at 3.00pm on Friday 17 June 2022. Late applications cannot be considered.
- 3. Applicants will be required to sit an audition on their principle instrument. Auditions will be in front of a small panel of chosen Instrumental Music specialists from our local professional music community.

- Applicants must be current Year 6 Instrumental Music students
- All applicants must complete an audition in order to be considered
- Successful applicants will be notified within two weeks of their audition date. The panel's decision will be final
- Successful applicants will be entitled to one (1) scholarship only to be used within the 2023 calendar year
- Scholarships cannot be transferred to another student or redeemed for cash
- Scholarships are only valid whilst the applicant remains an enrolled student at BRSHS
