Dear Parent/Guardian,

All Year 10 students at Bracken Ridge SHS are required to have a laptop to participate in school programs. In 2026, as part of a school trial, families now have the opportunity to choose from two options:

- BYOx laptop
- School purchased laptop (leased)

Option A: BYOx (trial in 2026 for year 10 ONLY)

Parent Information – BYOx Program (Bring Your Own Device)

At Bracken Ridge State High School, families have the option to participate in our **BYOx Program**, which allows students to bring their own laptop for learning at school.

What Parents Need to Know

Families are responsible for providing a laptop that meets the school's **minimum specifications**. These specifications ensure your child can successfully access all learning platforms and software used in class. Families will also need to manage any non-school provided software installations, repairs, and maintenance for your child's device. The school is not liable for any damage or theft of the device.

On Boarding BYOx Fee – \$30

To connect student devices to the school's digital learning systems, a fee **of \$30** is required. This fee supports:

- Secure access to the school network
- School internet with content filtering
- Secure access to on-campus printing services
- Paid prior to the device being on-boarded

Benefits of Participating in BYOx

Students and families who join the BYOx Program gain access to a number of valuable benefits:

- Student choice in laptop product
- Onboarding to the school network, including installation and support for essential software such as:
 - Microsoft Office Suite
 - QLearn
 - Teams
 - Compass
 - ClickView
 - OneDrive and H: Drive
- Internet filtering provided while at school
- Access to a limited number of loan devices (to be negotiated with the school), supplied if the student's laptop requires repair
- Flexibility for families to choose the make, model, and price point of a device that suits their needs and budget
- Choice to on-board a current year 9 device providing it meets the school specifications. Note: All warranty and ADP end with the year 9 laptop scheme 3-year agreement.

We strongly recommend purchasing a **protective laptop case** and considering **warranty or insurance coverage** to help protect the device from accidental damage.

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Minimum Device Specifications

Please note that all devices must meet the school’s **minimum technical requirements** to be connected to the network. Unfortunately, devices that don’t meet these specifications **will not be onboarded**.

Minimum specs are provided below.

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BYOx Program – Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Supporting informed decisions for your child’s learning device

1. What screen size is recommended for BYOx laptops?

We recommend a minimum screen size of 12 inches. Smaller screens are not practical for classroom tasks such as typing assignments, using spreadsheets, or engaging with learning platforms. Larger screens are acceptable but should still be portable.

2. How important is portability?

Very important. Your child will carry their device to and from school and between classes each day. Choose a device that is lightweight and compact without compromising screen size and functionality.

3. What battery life should we expect?

Battery life is influenced by processor type, screen brightness, and overall usage. Ideally, the laptop should last a full school day on a single charge. Encourage students to:

- Use battery saver mode
- Lower screen brightness

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- Avoid unnecessary use outside of class
- Note: Most laptop batteries have a lifespan of 3–5 years.

4. How do students connect to the internet at school?

Students connect to the Bracken Ridge SHS Wi-Fi network, which includes filtered internet access and access to learning platforms. At home, students use your personal Wi-Fi.

5. What storage capacity should the laptop have?

Most modern laptops come with sufficient storage, but we recommend discussing storage with your supplier. Aim for at least 256GB of SSD storage to support school-related files and software over several years.

6. Should we insure the laptop?

Yes. We strongly recommend you review your Home and Contents Insurance policy and consider additional device-specific insurance to protect against theft and accidental damage (e.g. drops, liquid spills, or loss).

7. Is a padded laptop case necessary?

Yes. A padded carry case, separate from the standard school bag, helps protect the device from:

- Drops
- Moisture
- Dust

This will extend the overall lifespan of the device.

8. What antivirus protection is needed?

Windows 11 includes Windows Defender, which is sufficient for most school use. Additional antivirus is optional but should not use VPNs, as these interfere with school internet filtering and may block network access at BRSHS.

9. How much should we spend on a BYOx laptop?

Consider both price and durability. A well-cared-for higher-quality device may last longer and provide better long-term value. Cheaper devices may cost less upfront but may need replacement sooner.

10. Should we purchase an extended warranty?

Yes, if available. Many retailers offer extended warranties (up to three years) to cover hardware faults or failures. This is especially valuable during the student's senior years when consistent device access is critical.

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Option B – School-Purchased (Leased) Laptop:

Student Laptop Resource Scheme – Bracken Ridge State High School

Bracken Ridge State High School offers families the option to participate in the Student Laptop Program (School-Purchased Device – Leased). This program provides students with a school-managed laptop that meets all curriculum and digital learning platform requirements.

Device Provision and Ownership

Under the scheme, the school supplies and manages the device at a cost, including all software, technical support, and warranty services. Families can choose to pay for the device in one of two ways:

- **First option, one-year payment.** Full payment made upfront; ownership of the device is transferred to the family once payment is completed.
- **Second option:** Flexible payment schedule arranged through the Business Manager; ownership is transferred once the final payment is completed.

Warranty and Repair Information

Devices are issued to students for a three-year period, concluding at the end of Year 12 in 2028. These devices are covered under warranty for the duration of this period. If a student leaves the school before the end of the program, families may retain the device provided that the device has been fully paid for. The school is not liable for any damage or theft of the device.

At the end of Year 12, once all accounts are finalised:

- The laptop will be reset to factory settings.
- Software licensing will be issued in the student's name.

An **Accidental Damage Protection (ADP)** policy is included. Please note the excess charges for warranty repairs:

- \$50 for the first repair
- \$100 for the second repair
- Full cost of repair for the third and subsequent incidents

Scheme Benefits

Families participating in the Laptop Resource Scheme gain access to the following benefits:

- Pre-installed and maintained curriculum software (Microsoft Office, QLearn, Teams, Compass, ClickView, OneDrive)
- Secure access to the school network and antivirus software
- School internet with content filtering
- Secure access to on-campus printing services
- Full technical support via the school's **Tech Desk (8:00am – 4:00pm)**
- Access to loan devices during repair periods
- Warranty claim management
- ADP claim management
- Laptop case

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Making an Informed Choice

This scheme is designed to ensure students have reliable access to digital learning tools while relieving families of technical and software management responsibilities.

Further information, including the **ICT Acceptable Use Agreement**, is available on our website: Student Laptop Resource Scheme and ICT Policy. Alternatively, printed copies are available from the School Administration during office hours.

Each year, the school partners with suppliers to secure bulk pricing and confirm the device for the following year. Once finalised, families will receive detailed device specifications and price.

- Estimated cost \$1000. (Includes warranties, software and case)

Switching from BYOx to School Purchased Laptop Scheme.

If a student wishes to switch from a BYOx device to the school laptop program, please be aware that this will depend on the availability of devices at the time and full laptop payment will be required.

Under this option, the school purchases the laptop and manages all software, warranty repairs, and technical support. Families have the flexibility to pay as mentioned in option B (page 5).

Estimated total cost for families:

- \$1,000 total

(exact cost to be confirmed when order is placed at the end of 2025)

Repair excess fees apply:

- \$50 for the first repair
- \$100 for the second repair
- Full cost of repair for any subsequent incidents

Payments: As part of the device program, families agree to the following payment schedule:

1. A **non-refundable deposit of \$300** is due by **Friday, 7 November 2025**.
2. The **outstanding balance** must be paid in full by **Friday, 30 January 2026** prior to the student collecting the device or as arranged with the business manager.
3. Families will be invoiced for the amount.

Please note: Laptop payments should preferably be made via BPoint using the provided Reference or Invoice Number. Alternatively, payments can be made directly to the Finance Office staff.
