#### Our Goal:

The goal for the scheme is to provide technology options that are affordable to families while, at the same time, meeting the needs of our staff, students and school.

- Laptops and Desktops are widely used in the school currently to assist in student learning. Our
  curriculum is fast moving to an E-Learning style and we wish to ensure the highest delivery options
  and service to our students.
- Online Learning environments are being established to offer access to learning 24/7, 365 days/yr.

In 2018 we introduced a successful Laptop Resource Scheme for Years 10-12 at BRSHS, with 95% uptake from all families for the Laptop Scheme.

In 2022 we commenced a Laptop Scheme for Years 7 also. If you have students starting Year 7, Please see Year 7 documentation on website as pricing is different.

Bracken Ridge SHS feel our scheme in comparison to BYO provides the best option for device configuration, student safety, efficient technical support, minimising and supporting cost for families and strong student outcomes.

Students and parents/caregivers are asked to lend their support to this very valuable and innovative Laptop Scheme. Strong support from parents and caregivers is paramount to ensure the Laptop Scheme is successful and that students gain the maximum benefit.

This program only supports school owned devices, being provided to students for educational use at school and at home. In order to maintain the security of Department of Education and Training (DET's) network and supported Managed Operating Environment (MOE), privately-owned devices will not be connected to the network.

Every year in September we liaise with our suppliers organising bulk quotes and when we finalise those prices and choose the next years device, we will send out device information, a full payment form with payment dates, Acceptance of Handbook and Charter agreement as well as Internet Filtering level assignment requests. #### Benefits of our scheme.

#### **School Owned Take-Home Resource Scheme**

- ✓ Option for a 3-year payment plan following \$500 deposit before collection in January 2023
- ✓ ADP and warranty for 3 years included in total cost.
- ✓ Commercial Grade devices.
- ✓ Technical support given between 7.30am and 4.30pm onsite.
- ✓ Devices will be MOE'd which provides the same platform as all other devices in the school and for student and staff continuity.
- ✓ Support from DET Service Centre for password issues etc when at home.
- ✓ Onsite warranty repairs from the supplier usually the Next Business Day if logged before 12pm.
- ✓ Hotswap devices available if a device has to be left for repair and is not usable for a couple of days.
- ✓ Computrace is activated to track stolen/lost devices.
- ✓ Less stress on the network and teachers to have the same platform across the school.
- ✓ At the end of the payment period and following the final payment the laptop will be returned to OEM state and ownership and any remaining warranty/ADP transferred for a small \$25 fee. Year 12s ONLY.

#### Our Aim:

- School Purchases 12" ULV Laptop including Bag and ADP per Year 10 student following the payment of deposit fee. We aim to keep cost approx. \$1000 dependant on supplier price changes.
- Parents are advised that these laptops will be used in all classes and are requested to pay resource hire fee at a cost of \$500 deposit before delivery to students + 2x payments (~\$300 + \$200) over two years.
- The Laptop Resource Scheme allows for the device to be carried by the student to all classes and home for continuity of studies. There will be an appropriate case provided for travel protection.

We have made a final decision on our purchase for next year based on price and specifications when comparing suppliers and ordering is being finalised.

The Acer SPIN B311 has an included stylus which docks in the base of the laptop where-as other suppliers a stylus would be an extra fee.

We have kept the cost as low as possible while providing a suitable device including the Everki Hardcase for the protection of the device. Cost from last year has increased only \$24.

Total cost for the package is \$1063 – payment options below.
