Targeted I4S funds will be used for a range of initiatives that support the growth and development of students and staff. Our funding will be used to:

- Provide targeted literacy instruction for identified student groups.
- Provide additional support for our senior students through academic and pathways coaching, transition support and industry engagement.
- Release time for collegial engagement and observations.
- Increase cultural engagement for our Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students.
- Student assessments to support differentiation and targeted teaching.

Our initiatives include:

- Teacher release time to allow participation in collegial engagement.
- Professional development to support *Visible Learning* professional development.
- Literacy intervention for students who need additional support to engage with the mainstream curriculum.
- Continued employment of a Student Support Officer to improve attendance, engagement and retention.
- Provide learning support and cultural opportunities for identified student groups.
- Funding assessments for students to identify learning needs and to assist teachers with differentiation.

Our school will improve student outcomes by:

- \$100,000 Literacy Intervention Teacher
- \$45,000 Engagement of Student Support Officer
- \$40,000 Senior Schooling and Industry Liason Officer
- \$20,000 Staff professional development
- \$15,000 Release time for collegial observation program
- \$10,000 Indigenous education programs
- \$7,016 Student assessments and support
