Winter School is a support program at the end of Semester 1.

It is generally a 2-day process designed to help students complete outstanding assessment and any required VET qualifications so they stay on track for senior schooling.



1 WHO ATTENDS?



- Students with outstanding assessment requirements



- Students who have not yet completed required VET qualification work



- Families of students required to attend will be notified by the school



2 IF YOU ARE REQUIRED TO ATTEND



Attendance is compulsory



Attend all scheduled sessions or remain until required work is completed



Any absence must be explained by a parent or carer



Students receive support to complete assessment tasks and course requirements



Once all required work is completed, students may sign out through the school office and leave



3 IF YOU ARE NOT REQUIRED TO ATTEND



- Students who are up to date with assessment and VET requirements do not need to attend



- These students complete independent study from home for their core subjects



- Students who wish to attend to work on other subjects can notify the school office so supervision can be arranged



- Students attending voluntarily will work in supervised Winter School classrooms
