Application Process

1. Complete the application available from the school website or office
2. Return the completed application form to Bracken Ridge State High School, Administration Office, in an envelope clearly marked BURSARY APPLICATION.' Applications close at 3.00pm on Friday 7 November 2025. Late applications cannot be considered.
3. Applicants will be required to meet with the Deputy Principal Junior School and P&C President in the week beginning 17 November to discuss the information in your application.

Terms and Conditions

- Applicants must be current Year 6 students.
- All applicants will be notified in writing no later than Friday 28 November 2025.
- Successful applicants will be entitled to one (1) Bursary only to be used within the 2026 calendar year.
- The Bursary cannot be transferred to another student or redeemed for cash.
- Successful Bursary applicants will be presented with their bursary at their school's Year 6 Graduation/school's award ceremony.
- The bursary funds can be used for the Student Resource Scheme, or other school related activities.
- Bursary funds are held within the school and distributed accordingly.
