Targeted I4S funds will be used for a range of initiatives that support the growth and development of students and staff. Our funding will be used to:

- Plan additional interventions for students with low attendance
- Provide social work support for families within our community to reduce barriers to successful engagement
- Provide additional support for our senior students through academic coaching, transition support and industry engagement
- Provide resources for literacy and numeracy intervention
- Release teachers for collegial engagement and observations
- Fund programs for students with disabilities
- Develop an expanded pedagogical framework
- Increase opportunities for our indigenous students
- Allow for the identification of barriers to learning through a range of student assessments

Our initiatives include:

- Teacher release time to allow participation in collegial engagement as part of a multi-level framework for teacher professional growth and development. The release time will facilitate teacher observation and feedback to improve teacher practice.
- Professional development to support the reengagement with, and expansion of our pedagogical framework to include a broader range of evidence-based teaching strategies and approaches.
- Release time, resources and support for the implementation of tier two and tier three literacy programs.
- Literacy intervention for students who need additional support to engage with the mainstream curriculum.
- Continued employment of a Student Support Officer to improve attendance and retention of students.
- Provide learning and cultural opportunities and support for identified student groups.
- Funding assessments for students to identify learning needs early in their high school years. The school will utilise a range of specialists to assist with identification and support of students.

Our school will improve student outcomes by:

- \$55,428 Engagement of Student Support Officer
- \$45,000 Social work support for families
- \$38,000 Senior Schooling and Industry Liaison
- \$20,000 Literacy Intervention Program
- \$20,000 SWD programs and support
- \$20,000 Release time for collegial observation program
- \$20,000 Staff professional development
- \$12,000 Indigenous education programs
- \$8,000 Student assessments and support
